

**Response to Questions Received by the
Florida Developmental Disabilities Council, Inc.
Regarding RFP-Assistive Technology Feasibility Study**

1. Estimated number of printed copies to be provided to the Council. Should that be the same number as defined by the RFP for the proposal or do you suggest a different number?

Answer:

The RFP process is a formal bidding process and respondents are encouraged to submit their best "bid" for consideration. The final number of copies to be produced and submitted to the Council is an item that can be discussed and negotiated as a part of Contract Negotiations.

2. The \$100,000 [funding] limit- does that include indirects and/or the mandatory cost share amounts?

Answer:

The project funding limits listed in the RFP refer to the available funds from the Council and do not include the required match (cost share).

3. Can the in-kind cost share be our University's Facilities & Administration (indirect) costs charged to the project up to the maximum of 50% allowable?

Answer:

Facilities and Administration (indirect costs) can be reported as in-kind costs/ match for the project.
