

Questions Submitted For RFP # 2011-HC-9005 – Physician Training Program

Questions submitted by The American Academy of Developmental Medicine and Dentistry:

1. What physician education level does the FDDC intend to target with this grant (medical school, residency level or continuing education)?

Answer: FDDC anticipates that this project will focus on resident level training and continuing education for practicing physicians who provide care for adults.

2. What type of education format is preferred? For example, residency-based training with a hands-on clinical component, a state-wide conference, online didactic training, or some other format?

Answer: The specific format will be developed based upon proposals received and contract negotiations. In general, we are looking for an education format that will be informative, cost-effective, sustainable, and will appeal to residents and physicians.

3. Would there be an objection to moving the goal “Partnering with appropriate stakeholders to pursue including this training for physicians in residency programs in Florida” from the anticipated timeline of Year 2 to Year 1 of the project? (Given the current state of our national effort and depending on a number of other factors, it may be possible for us to move more quickly into this phase of the project than would otherwise be expected).

Answer: We anticipate that Year 1 of the project will focus on the development and approval of a strong training program. The specific timelines and services to be provided will be developed during contract negotiations with the selected offeror.
