

List of Questions Received for Request for Bids #2022-HCS-8000 Training First Responders Project

1. Our concern is the required match: <u>Required Match: A match of not less</u> than 25% of the approved cost of the project is required. Is there any possible way to proceed without the required match?

Answer: Effective August 1, 2022, the Florida Developmental Disabilities Council, Inc. amended the match requirement for Request for Bids #2022-HCS-8000 via Addendum #1. Specifically, FDDC is no longer requiring a match of not less than 25% of the approved cost of the project, a revised Budget Request Form has been posted, and match will not be assessed as part of the minimum requirements to determine responsiveness. 2. The request lists the project timeline as September 30, 2022 to September 29, 2023. However, the opening paragraph states "in the planned second year of the project". So, I wanted to clarify the expected timeline for the project.

Answer: This project is slated for September 30, 2022 to September 29, 2023. There are funds earmarked to continue this project for a second year during which a train-the-trainer curriculum will be developed and training will be provided across the state. Information included in this request for bids relates only to the Scope of Work for the first year of the project.
